Staffing

As stated in our Newsletter last week Mrs Crowley will join us as Depute Head Teacher following the Christmas break. She will not have a teaching commitment next term. This does mean that the current Acting Head Teachers, Mrs Mateer and Mrs Macaulay will return to their roles as Principal Teachers, with a class commitment.

Furthermore, Mrs Grant (P3/4) and Miss Almond who has been covering in various classes will leave us to take up new posts in other schools. Miss Malloch, who has been covering in the P3 class and working closely with Mrs Grant this term, will take over the class teacher responsibility in P3/4 until the summer with Mrs Ross still taking the class on a Thursday. P5A – Mrs Mateer (Mon-Thu) Ms Coe (Tue and Fri)

Miss Macaulay and Mrs Mateer each have ½ a day management time each week and will arrange with their respective teachers whether this will be taken as a day a fortnight or ½ a day a week. Ms Coe will remain three days in the school but, will support in other areas of class cover across the school, alongside her teaching in P5A.

We would like to welcome new staff to the school and thank both Mrs Grant and Miss Almond for their hard work and efforts with Milton of Leys and wish them our very best as they move on to new and exciting roles.
